Camp Kit List

Below is a list of kit that you will normally need for camps. Depending on the activity, extra items may be required or some pieces of equipment may not be allowed.

- Sturdy Rucksack (35+ litres) to hold all your kit
- Sleeping Bag (with stuff sack)
- Roll Mat
- Suitable Clothing and Footwear (preferably walking boots/old trainers)
- Changes of Clothes (at least 1 for a one-night camp)
- Change of Footwear
- Waterproofs - coat and trousers
- Wash Kit and Towel
- Eating Stuff - Fork, Knife, Spoon, Plate, Bowl, Mug
- Water Bottle
- 2 old Tea Towels
- Small Rucksack
- First Aid Kit
- Torch, spare batteries and bulb
- Emergency Rations
- Survival Bag (if you have one)
- Pen and Paper
- Small Sewing Set (optional)
- Watch
- Sun Hat, Sun Cream (seasonal)
- Uniform and Hanger (only for longer camps)

You are reminded that electronic equipment is generally not allowed during Scouting activities. The only notable exception is during a Hike, when Patrol Leaders are allowed to have a mobile phone for emergency use only.
